1	FOR AN	ACT relating to postsecondary educational institutions;								
2		to amend section 85-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of								
3	3 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to determination									
4		of residency; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the								
5		original section.								

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 85-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 85-502 Rules and regulations established by the governing 4 board of each state <u>postsecondary</u> educational institution shall 5 require as a minimum that a person shall not be <u>is not</u> deemed 6 to have established a residence in this state, for the purpose 7 purposes of sections 85-501 to 85-504, unless:

8 (1) Such person is of legal age or is an emancipated 9 minor and shall have <u>has</u> established a home in Nebraska where he 10 or she is habitually present for a minimum period of one hundred 11 eighty days, with the bona fide intention of making this state his 12 or her permanent residence, supported by documentary proof;

13 (2) The parents, parent, or guardian having custody of 14 a minor registering in the educational institution shall have 15 established a home in Nebraska where such parents, parent, or guardian are or is habitually present with the bona fide intention 16 17 of such parents, parent, or guardian to make this state their, his, or her permanent residence, supported by documentary proof. 18 If a student + PROVIDED, that if a person has matriculated in 19 20 any state postsecondary educational institution while his or her 21 parents, parent, or guardian had an established home in this state, 22 and the parents, parent, or guardian leave ceases to reside in 23 the state, such person student shall not thereby lose his or her 24 resident status by reason of such parents, parent, or guardian 25 having ceased to reside in this state if such person student has

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1 the bona fide intention to make this state his or her permanent 2 residence, supported by documentary proof;

3 (3) Such <u>person student</u> is of legal age and is a 4 dependent for federal income tax purposes of a parent or former 5 guardian₇ who shall have <u>has</u> established a home in Nebraska where 6 he or she is habitually present with the bona fide intention of 7 making this state his or her permanent residence, supported by 8 documentary proof;

9 (4) Such <u>person student</u> is a nonresident of this state 10 prior to marriage, and marries a person who has established a home 11 in Nebraska where he or she is habitually present with the bona 12 fide intention of making this state his or her permanent residence, 13 supported by documentary proof;

14 (5) Such person Except as provided in subdivision (8) of 15 this section, such student, if an alien, shall have has applied 16 to or has a petition pending with the United States Immigration 17 and Naturalization Service to attain lawful status under federal 18 immigration law and has established a home in Nebraska for a period 19 of at least one hundred eighty days where he or she is habitually 20 present with the bona fide intention to become a permanent resident 21 alien of the United States and make this state his or her permanent 22 residence, supported by documentary proof;

23 (6) Such <u>person student</u> is a staff member or <u>a</u> dependent
24 of a staff member of the University of Nebraska, one of the
25 Nebraska state colleges, or one of the community college areas who

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1 joins the staff immediately prior to the beginning of a term from 2 an out-of-state location;

3 (7) Such <u>person student</u> is on active duty with the armed 4 services of the United States and has been assigned a permanent 5 duty station in Nebraska, or is a legal dependent of a person on 6 active duty with the armed services of the United States assigned a 7 permanent duty station in Nebraska; or

8 (8) Such person is a graduate of a high school of this
9 state or has been previously registered in a state educational
10 institution at a time when he or she was a resident of this state.
11 (8) (a) Such student resided with his or her parent,
12 guardian, or conservator while attending a public or private high
13 school in this state and:

14 (i) Graduated from a public or private high school in 15 this state or received the equivalent of a high school diploma in 16 this state;

17 (ii) Resided in this state for at least three years
18 before the date the student graduated from the high school or
19 received the equivalent of a high school diploma;

20 <u>(iii) Registered as an entering student in a state</u>
21 postsecondary educational institution not earlier than the 2006
22 <u>fall semester; and</u>

23 <u>(iv) Provided to the state postsecondary educational</u> 24 <u>institution an affidavit stating that he or she will file</u> 25 <u>an application to become a permanent resident at the earliest</u>

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1	opportunity	he	or	she	is	eligible	to	do	so.

2 (b) If the parent, guardian, or conservator with whom the 3 student resided ceases to reside in the state, such student shall 4 not lose his or her resident status under this subdivision if the 5 student has the bona fide intention to make this state his or her 6 permanent residence, supported by documentary proof. 7 Sec. 2.
